

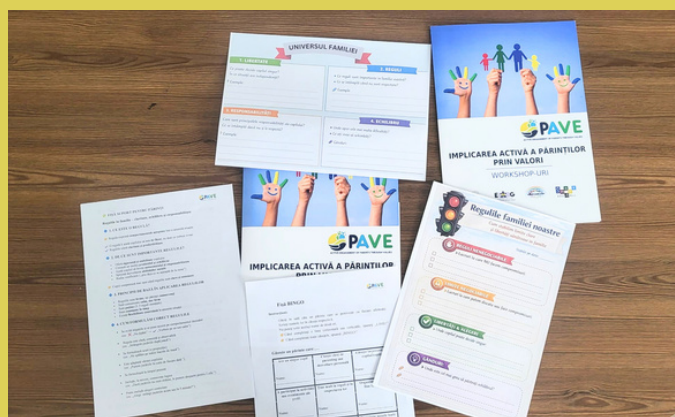

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PROGRESS UPDATE

WORKSHOPS WITH PARENTS

Between November and March, the PAVE project entered its testing phase, engaging a total of approximately 182 parents across the three partner countries. During this period, all four workshops were successfully implemented, featuring interactive and experiential activities designed to raise parents' awareness of key educational values. The sessions encouraged active participation and motivated parents to continue working on these values at home, strengthening family relationships and everyday interactions.

Following the workshops, participants completed feedback questionnaires. These responses are currently being used to develop a personalized intra-family values matrix, which each family will receive during the final stage of the project. This tool will support parents in continuing their value-based approach within the family environment.

The project will conclude with a final meeting dedicated to celebrating the parents' involvement and the work carried out at home. This event will provide an opportunity for participants to share impressions, exchange ideas, and highlight good practices, while also strengthening the connection between families and the school community.





LT TA SPAIN

On April 16–18, project partners met in Spain for a Learning, Teaching and Training Activity (LT TA) focused on analyzing the results of the testing phase and advancing the project's final outputs.

During this meeting, partners worked collaboratively to review and analyze the feedback collected from parents and facilitators through the questionnaires. This process provided valuable insights into the effectiveness of the workshops and the impact of the activities implemented.

Based on this analysis, the team developed a personalized intra-family values matrix for each participating family, designed to support the continued application of values in everyday family life.

In addition, all workshop activities were carefully reviewed, refined, and updated, resulting in their final version. These materials will be made available on the project website and shared with relevant stakeholders, ensuring wider dissemination and long-term impact of the project outcomes.





FUTURE PLANS

As the PAVE project approaches its final stage, two key resources will soon be available:

- Intra-family Values Matrix – a personalized tool designed to support families in applying values in their daily interactions and strengthening relationships at home.
- Methodological Toolkit for Workshops – a structured set of activities and guidelines for educators and facilitators, aimed at supporting the implementation of value-based workshops with parents.

These materials will be published on the project website and shared with relevant stakeholders, contributing to the sustainability and wider impact of the PAVE project.

UPCOMING ACTIVITIES

As the PAVE project moves towards completion, several key activities are planned:

- Final meeting with parents – a celebration event dedicated to recognizing their involvement and the work carried out at home, as well as sharing experiences, ideas, and good practices.
- Finalization of project materials – including the Intra-family Values Matrix and the Methodological Toolkit, which will be made available for broader use.
- Multiplier events and dissemination – activities aimed at sharing the project results with a wider audience of educators, stakeholders, and communities, ensuring long-term impact and sustainability.





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
